This unique garden features a long cascading waterfall, several ponds, thousands of varieties of plants, a Japanese Tea House, statuary and a forty-foot arbour.

Lucy Maud Montgomery Historical Society

We will travel cross country to Leaskdale, near Uxbridge, to visit the former home and commemorative garden of L.M. Montgomery, author of Canada's beloved Anne of Green Gables. She lived in the area from 1911 to 1926 and wrote 11 of her 22 books here. The property has been designated a provincial and national heritage site. In the garden, a statue of Maud sitting on a bench overlooking the fields she loved, welcomes you.
